Hey y'all. I begin with a confession as your new Area Chairperson. Going on 17 years ago there was a dusty old copy of When I Got Busy, I Got Better (P-78) in the CAL collection of my first home group. I clearly remember chuckling to myself because it seemed a step backwards- the title is directly related to one of the symptoms that brought me here – extreme "busyness". What I read was "When I Got Busy, I Got Dangerous!" Holding life together without Recovery was and continues to be threatening to every aspect of my health. At some point I read that CAL and it clearly was about the value of Service (our third Legacy). Yet still, even in service I must watch out for this character defect.

As we approach our first Assembly the responsibility of this new job still feels strange. There have been transition tasks since the election in November, always with plenty of support but at times it has felt like I'm dancing backwards in high heels as Ginger Rogers said. In these early challenges, your counsel and support always reminded me that it's a WE program, to share the burden, and that Busy the Bully is no longer welcome in my Recovery.

The first time I sat down in the Rooms, there was no denying that my life was unmanageable, and you accepted me. Over sixteen years later, I stood for this position not motivated by confidence that I could do it perfectly, but motivated by the awareness that willingness and humility is far more important than experience or skill. I stood because a voice inside said - "Barbara, you can't do this - but I can do it in you. We can continue to change and free you if you will trust the process."

Let's see if I grow and change as was promised. My intention is to dance backward in high heels listening to the music, regularly changing partners, learning new steps so I can avoid doing the foxtrot when a tango is playing. I want to move through life full of gratitude, joyfully and gracefully attracting others to join us in the freeing dance of Service.

# Ask it Basket Questions From November 2015 Assembly

- 1. Why is transition from panel 53 to 56? Not to 54? Answer: See Service manual Page 173. Each panel serves a 3 year term (Colleen served panel 53 for the years 2013, 14, 15) One third of all delegates are elected every 3 years for a 3 year term.
- 2. IF someone is elected by gr's who do not have negative info about a candidate, can this person be removed from office for violation of trusted servant status for illegal activity? *Answer: AlAnon is not punitive, See Warranty 4.*
- 3. Under what circumstances can a delegate be asked to leave office? Answer:If someone is not doing their job or not going to meetings we can certainly talk to them. Try to reason things out.
- 4. What Action would be taken if a person under 18 showed up and wanted to participate in a meeting? Answer: Service manual page 33 last sentence. Page 33 is about Alateen meetings. Anyone age 1318 can attend Alateen. AlAnon is also for Alateen when no Alateen meeting is available. Members decided for themselves if they belong in AlAnon, we do not Police our meetings.
- 5. Our group chooses not to do the "keep coming back chant..." at the end of our meeting. What are the pros and cons to share with my group for the reason why? Answer: The Service Manual page 10 has a meeting format, with the suggested closing on page 22. Lois herself said to close our meetings with a spiritual moment. Chants have been discussed at the world service conference and you can search the summaries for those discussions. Always remember the newcomers when changing group formats.
- 6. I have heard 2 people, when speaking, they are from panel 41 what is panel 41? Answer: At first I thought I misheard. Oregon Area guidelines ask when members go to speak to say their name, district and position. These persons served on

#### panel 41 (the years 2001, 2002 and 2003).

- 7. Pg 63 of the Service manual says: "AlAnon information Service (AIS) is a local service established and maintained by one or more districts or by groups?" Therefore, if AIS is established by the district, and the district has voted not to participate in a non-AA sanctioned event. How/why would AIS choose to participate by providing a literature table, distributing flyers announcing AlAnon participation and recruiting within district groups for volunteers and speakers and encouraging AlAnon to attend? Who has authority? District or AIS? Answer: Every group, district and AIS is autonomous...(Tradition 4). Groups have different members, different ideas, different input and make changes through their group conscience. We need to remember the second part of Tradition 4, except in matters matters affecting another group, AlAnon or AA as a whole.
- 8. When someone stands for the delegate position (or any other position) and is unqualified because they have violated trusted servant principles or have committed illegal acts during a previous panel or time frame and voting GRs don't know about this, how can this vital breach of information be shared with voting GRs? Who will share it? What happens if people who know do not make it known? Answer: Our area does give time to those who do have something to say. If no one comes to the mic, that is their choice. Unqualified, violated principles committed illegal acts??? This could mean many different things to many members. Are you comfortable talking to this person or maybe having a group talk with them? We are not punitive and we do have faith in our Higher Power. So maybe turn it over and trust that more shall be revealed?

We are not discontinuing the magazine – only the distribution of the free monthly copies to the Englishspeaking groups. You can continue to read The Forum with a paid group subscription. Also, individual members can subscribe electronically for \$1.49 per issue and access the magazine by smart phone or other device. Al-Anon's monthly magazine contains meaningful sharings of experience, strength, and hope from members around the world. Don't miss out!

We are sorry for the necessity of discontinuing free copies, but hope your group has appreciated receiving The Forum.

Oregon Area Al-Anon Family Groups: Guidelines

#### **Alateen Standing Committee**

TERM LENGTH: Three Years (Beginning January 1, after appointment)

<u>DESCRIPTION:</u> established by Area Motion in July 2012, committee members are the Alternate Delegate (Chair), the Area Alateen Coordinator, the Area Alateen Process Person, and a member appointed by the Area Chairperson who is currently active as a District Representative or with DR experience. Committee members have voice and vote at the Area World Service Committee (AWSC) meetings and voice only at Assemblies <u>unless</u> also a GR.

The primary purpose is to represent the interests of the Oregon Area in regards to the Oregon Alateen Conference (OAC) by "reviewing contracts, offering suggestions for the Alateen Conference budget, and determining the financial impact of proposed Conference plans. It is to present an annual report at Assemblies and to The COMMUNICATOR. The secondary purpose is to encourage effective communication and support throughout the Oregon Area for Alateen by cooperatively hosting annual training for District Representatives.


